Mr. Torrens reported that he had talked to the contact person in regards to the EPA's letter regarding the spreading of sludge in the Township from the Utica Waste Water Treatment facility. He reported it had been checked and was in compliance at the time, but not to hesitate reporting any problems that arise.

After reviewing the posting of vehicles and equipment to be sold by the State of Ohio, Mr. Hull felt it would be worth while to attend the sale on Sept. 1, 1987. He and Road Supt. Jerry Hull invited anyone else to accompany them. They will report back should they find something useful. If in agreement with the Board on any purchases a blank check was authorized to purchase any agreed item.

Mr. Torrens moved the meeting be adjourned, seconded by Mr. Hull. Motion carried.
