The Trustees' report that the pads have been almost completed and that they are very satisfied with the quality of material supplied by C R Surfacing. The base tar material is much thicker than that used last year and this should hold up under the weather much better. The only adverse comment from the public was the dust problem from sweeping the pads in preparation for the application of the chip and seal. This obviously could not be helped.

The Trustees discussed the blacktop on the ends of the Township roads that will soon be in need of repair if not already in need. The end of Bell Church is reported to be in the worst shape.

It was also reported that Tom Roberts is having problem's with three-wheeler's, four-wheeler's and four wheel drive pick-up's racing past his house. He would like to see this road closed however realizes that it would be a problem since the other end is in Newton Twp. He would however like to have the road chip and sealed beside his house if possible to keep down the dust problem caused by the traffic.

Mr. Wince moved that the meeting be adjourned, seconded by Mr. Hull. Carried.
