I certify that there are sufficient funds in the depository or in the process of collection to pay the above bills and checks of the Township have been issued in payment of the same.

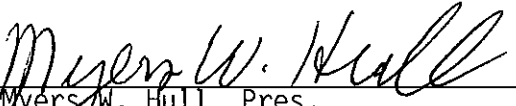

Mr. Wince and Mr. Hull discussed the summer convention and some of the topics brought up in the panel discussions. Both felt it was quite informative.

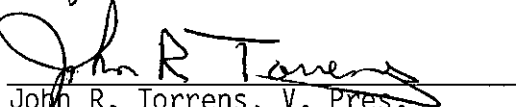
