The road ends were reported to be near completion. C&R Resurfacing should have the project completed by mid-week. They also repaired a pad which was not done properly when they resurfaced pads earlier in the year.

The Trustee's also agreed to meet on Sat. 10/8/1988 to travel to Fremont to look at a mower advertised which if a price could be settled upon and if the mower was what they felt was needed they might be able to purchase it.

It was also decided that since our funds were substantial it would be in the best interest of the Township to purchase a Certificate of Deposit. Since County Savings offers more interest it was felt we should obtain it there and in light of the fact we have had a depository relationship with them in the past. Since we would be together on Wed. the Clerk would have a check then.

Mr. Torrens moved that the meeting be adjourned, seconded by Mr. Hull. Motion carried.
