
The minutes of the meeting held November 28, 1988 were read and approved.

I certify that there are sufficient funds in the depository or in the process of collection to pay the above bills and that checks of the Township have been issued in payment of the same.



Mr. Torrens brought up the fact the Township must file 1099's for anyone who was paid over \$600.00 by the Township in 1988, that was or were not incorporated. The Clerk will determine who those are to be and take the necessary steps to complete these forms.


The Clerk reported that he was approached by Eden Township resident Jim Glover about the loose gravel at the intersection of Dog Hollow Rd. and Peat Moss Rd. on the curve. He had seen cars slide in the gravel and felt it could be a liability. The Road Supt. was instructed to check the situation out.

Mr. Torrens reported that someone had slid off the road at the entrance to the Torrens Rd. bridge and had snapped the protective cables leading to the bridge. The Trustee's felt this was a Township responsibility and would look into repairing or replacing the cables.

Mr. Wince moved that the meeting be adjourned, seconded by Mr. Hull, vote unanimous.
