The Clerk presented two letters, one from Small Paving requesting the opportunity to serve the Township as they had joined the County Assoc. This in turn brought up the fact that the Trustees were not happy with the job done by C & R Surfacing. Mr. Hull would check with them to see if any repairs could be done.

The seond letter was from County Prosecutor Bob Becker regarding junk cars and the remedy and legal action to take if the Township has this problem.

The Trustees also discussed some of the topics raised at the convention and the county meeting. The problem with Johnson Grass was discussed and the prominence of it in the Township. While it does not pose a major threat at this time it's potential is well realized by the Trustees.

Mr. Torrens also reorted that Debbie Kinney from the Prosecutor's office researched the cemetary problem and it was her feeling the Trustees could do very little at this time.

Mr. Torrens moved that the meeting be adjourned, seconded by Mr. Hull.
