


I certify that there are sufficient funds in the depository or in the process of collection to pay the above bills and that checks of the Township have been issued in payment of the same.



The Trustees discussed the options available on our pads in the Township. Although some have remained in fairly good shape, many will not hold up from year to year. Mr. Torrens brought the idea of spreading oil as McKeen Township has done. All the Trustees felt it was not worth spending so much money each year repairing the pads with chip and seal. The Trustees would check with McKeen on the cost of the oil application. It was also discussed if oil was to be used it would be a good idea to publish this in the paper to allow the public to know the application schedule.
