I certify taht there are sufficient funds in the depository or in the process of collection to pay the above bills and that checks of the Township have been issued in payment of the same.



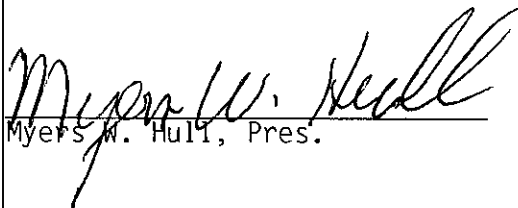

Mr. Torrens moved that the meeting be adjourned seconded by Mr. Hull. Vote unanimous.



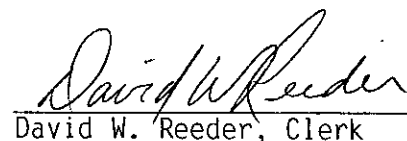
