Mr. Torrens moved the preceding bills be allowed as lawful obligations of the Township and that the Clerk be directed to issue warrents of the Township in payment of the same.


I certify there are sufficient funds in the depository or in the process of collection to pay the above bills and that checks of the Township have been issued in payment of the same.




