
The Emory family contacted the Board in regard to repairing the pad at their property and to see if some ditching could be done. The Trustees will look into this matter.


Mr. Torrens reported the creek at the old Haas property on Weaver Rd. needs cleaned out and repaired. There is a log blocking the flow of the creek at that site.
