



It was decided to get quotes for single shot chip and seal for the pads on Gingerhill Rd., Bell Church Rd., Richards Rd., and Hunt Rd. This would be approximately the same amount of pads done last year on Peat Moss Rd. and Cooksey Rd.


Mr. Hull reported that he would have Roger start mowing with the small tractor and mower, as Jerry still has not been released by the Doctor.
