Almost the entire meeting revolved around the closing of the bridge on Rt. 13 in St. Louisville and the many problems it has created. Mr. Londot reported calls from several citizens including Mrs. Lake, Barbara Cummins, and Gail Wolfe, owner of Dry Creek Gravel. Mrs. Lake and Mrs. Cummins complained of all the traffic and truck travel and of course Mr. Wolfe complained of closing the road to thru trucks. Mrs. Lake asked that a CHILDREN PLAYING sign be erected on Weaver Rd. Mr. Torrens will take care of this. Due to the extreme dust on Weaver Rd. the Trustees contacted Clayton King to spread salt water which has already been done. Mr. Londot reported the small bridge on Weaver Rd. seemed somewhat undercut and perhaps a Load Limit could be placed on the bridge as a further reason to keep trucks off Weaver Rd. Mr. Torrens will contact Timm Lollo at the Engineer's office to examine the bridge. After much discussion Mr. Torrens moved for a resolution concerning Weaver and Smoots Rds. Therefore:

Resolution

Mr. Torrens moved that the Trustees post "NO THRU TRUCKS" signs on Weaver Rd. and Smoots Rd. due to the closing of the bridge in St. Louisville. Mr. Londot seconded. Vote unanimous.

Therefore be it resolved by the Washington Township Trustees that the above request be submitted to the Licking County Commissioners for their approval.

Mr. Londot will call the Highway Patrol and Mr. Torrens will call the Sheriff's Dept. regarding the resolution. It was also decided that Marc Guthrie be called regarding any help the State might be able to give.

Mr. Reeder reported Sue McElwain would record our Zoning Appeals hearing to be held June 20, 1990.




