The Trustee's learned at their meeting with Chris Savage that Issue 2 funding does not apply to gravel roads for asphalt coverage. She did however pledge to help in any way she could with our application for whatever we choose to do.

The Clerk reported that he had talked with Steve Little at the Board of Elections and that Steve had suggested the Board go with a replacement levy for the EMS rather than a renewal. Debbie Kinney would be sending a letter regarding this. Mr. Hull moved that we change the language to read replacement rather than renewal. Mr. Torrens seconded the motion, vote unanimous.

Randy Wheeler of the Zoning Appeals Board wishes to have the transcript of the Zoning hearing typed. The Clerk will call Sylvia McElwain and request the same.

Mr. Hull reported Cumberland Oil Comp. had be in contact with him regarding building a ditch across Bell Church Rd. so they could set up service for the Cornelious' family. Mr. Hull will continue to monitor there work.
