Ken Cunningham from Martinsburg Rd. in the Township was present to discuss his problems regarding adjoining property owners and the lack of fences between their properties. He had approached Emerson Stout about sharing the cost and construction of fence along their joint property line. Since the meeting was not cordial he came to the Trustees for their suggestions and what his legal responsibilities and options are. He had previously talked with Mr. Londot concerning this matter and Mr. Torrens had checked with the County Prosecutor's Office. Mr. Torrens obtained forms from the Prosecutor for each step of the proceedings and Mr. Cunningham was given the form proceedings upon complaint. The Trustees urged Mr. Cunningham to first try to talk and work with the adjoining owners before filing a complaint.

The Trustees also discussed a proposed joint application with Newton Twp for Issue 2 funding. Some informal discussions have been held with the Newton Trustees and with the County Engineer's office regarding such a project. The Trustees agreed to start formalizing a plan for such a project and to begin the paper work needed for such an application. It was also agreed to meet with Newton for an informal work session on Sept. 27, 1990 since they have already been through the application process and they could shed light on what the integrating committee would expect. The project will be in regards to Weaver Rd. and figures regarding extra costs for Weaver Rd. since the bridge closing will be obtained for this meeting.

Mr. Londot moved the meeting be adjourned, seconded by Mr. Hull. Vote unanimous
