Ken Cunningham reported he had not been able to resolve his fence problem with the adjoining landowners to his property. His wish was to take the next step and file a complaint with the Trustees for a viewing of the fences. The Trustee's decided that they would visit the adjoining landowners first to see if a resolution could be obtained without formal action. They agreed to visit with Mr. Emerson Stout and Mr. John Balka on Wed. Sept. 26, 1990 to try to obtain a settlement agreeable to both parties. If a resolution can not be obtained they agreed at the next meeting a formal notice to view the fence would be sent.

The Trustees reported that Mr. Bennett on Weaver Rd. had complained of water washing gravel over the end of a culvert at his driveway. This had caused water backup at his property. The Trustees stated a large part of this problem was caused by his own septic system. The problem will be looked into.

The joint application with Newton Township was again discussed with the work session scheduled for Sept. 27th being prepared for. All documents are just about completed, and photographs of Weaver and Smoots Roads haven been taken, the Trustees felt they were in a good position for the work session. Mr. Torrens moved for the attached resolution.

Mr. Londot moved the meeting be adjourned, seconded by Mr. Torrens. Vote unan.
