Present for the meeting were Trustees John R. Torrens, Myers W. Hull, Jack T. Londot, Clerk David W. Reeder.


The minutes of the meeting held Oct. 22, 1990 were read and approved.




Mr. Torrens also asked about the same problem on Torrens Rd. however Mr. Hanna stated he would leave that situation up to the Township.


The Trustees commented about both the EMS replacement levy and the new Fire Levy passing. For the lack of advertisement the Fire Levy was somewhat of a surprise.
