The Clerk reported he had checked with the Engineer's office regarding the needed road signs. Craig Smith reported their people would make the signs for us. All we need to do is give a least to his office. The Road Supt. will check the signs we have and report back what we need.

The Trustees again discussed which pads we would repair/and or construct this year. They decided chip and seal was not holding up so they would try Motorpaving this year. Stout Road will be done for sure and the long pad at the Peat Moss Farm would be repaired.

The contractors will be viewing Weaver and Smoots Rd. on Tues. July 17, 1991. The Road Supt. will mark all culverts and where the guardrail is to be installed on the roads before the viewing. It was reported four contractors picked up bid packages for the Weaver-Smoots Rehab Project. The opening of bidswill be held July 22, 1991 at 8:00 PM at the Newton Township House and the awarding of the bids will be July 29, 1991 at the same time and location.

Mr. Torrens requested we meet August 5, 1991 rather than August 12 due to vacation. The Trustees had no objection.

The Clerk presented the 1992 Budget and a hearing was held. With the estate money and new fire levy our budget now exceeds \$250,000.00.

Mr. Torrens moved the meeting be adjourned, seconded by Mr. Hull. Vote unanimous.
