
The minutes of the meeting held July 8, 1991, were read and approved.


The Trustees discussed the viewing of the Weaver-Smooths Rehab project held Tues July 17, 1991 with the contractors. The three contractors attending the viewing were representatives of The Shelly Comp., Kokosing Construction, and Ohio Asphalt dba Small's of Gambier.

The Clerk reported he had not yet received return receipt of the notice to Mr. David Berger regarding the line fence problem with Mr. Walter Nickells. A letter has been sent to Mr. Nickells explaining the procedures we must go through and what steps are involved.

There being no public in attendance the Trustees moved that the remainder of our meeting be transferred to Newton Township for the opening of the bids for the Weaver-Smooths Rehab Project. Upon that the Trustees left for Newton.


At Newton Township there were only two bids presented, one by The Shelly Comp. and one by Kokosing Construction. The Shelly Comp's bid was the lowest.
