Also present at the meeting were Paul and Emerson Stout with a concern regarding dust control on Stout Rd. They refuse to allow the Township to use salt water near their home and were there to discuss alternative solutions. As it turned out representatives from Dust Bomb in Mansfield, Ohio were present with a proposal for their form of dust control. The passed out brochures and explained their system to the Trustees and to the Stout's. After their proposal and questions and answers the Road Supt. escorted them to several areas of the Township for their viewing including the area concerning the Stout's. They were to then get back with the Board with a quote for the application of their product.

Also present were Steve Little and Roger Smith from the Eden Township Board of Trustees along with Debbie Kinney from their Township to discuss the joint Issue 2 project that has been proposed between our Townships. Discussion was had regarding the application procedure and our prior application from the Smoots-Weaver Rehab Project was given to them for their information and review.

The Trustees also discussed the awarding of the bid on July 29, 1991 to the Shelly Comp. as it was by far the lowest on our joint project with Newton regarding the Weaver-Smoots Rehab project.

The Road Supt. reported the tractor was worse than originally thought and a major overhaul would have to be completed for its repair. It is still in the shop at B&B Tractor.

Mr. Londot moved for adjournment, seocnded by Mr. Hull. Vote unanimous.
