Debbie Kinney from Eden delivered the Issue 2 agreement between Eden and Washington in regard to the proposed Graceland-Hunt Rehab Project. Mr. Londot moved for an agreement to go forward with the joint project, seconded by Mr. Myers, with the vote being unanimous.
