1. Resolution 92-01 - Mr. Torrens moved that James Dickson be given a deposit book and be allowed to deposit zoning fees directly into the Township's checking account. Seconded by Mr. Londot, vote unanimous.
2. Resolution 92-02 - Mr. Londot moved that the needed body repair on the 1979 Ford Dump Truck be done by Randy's Body & Garage, 136 1/2 Crestview Dr., Utica, at a cost of \$2529.28. Seconded by Mr. Torrens, vote unanimous.
3. Sammy Banks of Father - Son Contractors and Dick Bakir of D.A.I. were present to discuss dust control. The Trustees will allow Father - Son Contractors to spray one truckload of Dust Bond at a cost of \$875.00 at a later date to test the product.
4. The Trustees discussed tiling of Hunt Road before the Issue 2 project with Eden Township begins.
5. The Trustees and Jerry L. Hull discussed grading at the American Legion Baseball field.

Mr. Hull moved to adjourn, seconded by Mr. Torrens, vote unanimous.
