Meeting

Mr. Winkleman would like the Board of Trustees to allow him to file a variance application free of charge in exchange for dismissing his appeal; Winkleman vs Board of Zoning Appeals of Washington Township, Case #90-CV-93. The Board along with Mr. Wheeler and Mr. Dickson decided it would be best if the court made all decisions in this matter.
3. The Trustees and Mr. Dickson discussed the American Legion baseball field. Mr. Dickson reported that everything was in order.
4. The Trustees discussed the dust problem in the Township with no solution as of this time.
5. The construction of pads on Hull Rd. and on Cooksey Rd. were discussed. Also discussed was the repair or replacement of a culvert at Walter Anderson's home on Preston Rd.

Mr. Londot moved to adjourn, seconded by Mr. Torrens, vote unanimous.
