2. Sammy Banks and his son were also present and asked the Trustees how Wilson Rd. was holding up after the application of Dust Bond and if they would be purchasing any more Dust Bond this year. The Trustees thought that Wilson Rd. was in fair shape at this time and they would not be using Dust Bond on any other Township roads this year.
3. The Trustees will allow Mr. Burger to build his share of the Nickles-Burger line fence. Mr. Burger must follow the Trustees' guidelines as follows: The fence shall be constructed of a woven wire with posts 16 feet apart made of wood or steel, 47" high with one barb on top.
4. The Trustees directed the Clerk to advertise in the local paper that they will hold a special meeting July 2, 1992. The purpose of this meeting is to adopt a resolution to approve the application of brine to the Township roads.

Mr. Hull moved to adjourn, seconded by Mr. Londot, vote unanimous.
