1. Resolution 92-09 - Mr. Torrens moved that the 1993 budget be approved as is. Seconded by Mr. Hull, vote unanimous.
2. The Trustees instructed Jerry Hull to use brine on the township roads as needed.
3. The Trustees discussed repairing township pads for 1992. The following locations were proposed by the Board:
 - a) Cooksey Road: starting at Bill Lantz' home and going to Johnny Bell's home. Also at John Gleckler's property.
 - b) Hull Road: Barb Gallogly's property and Harvey Wilkinson's property. Both of these pads are to be repaved and extended. Also the pads at Thurman Treadway's and Jim Yost's properties will be repaved and joined.
 - c) Preston Road: The pad at Walter Anderson's property will be repaved.
- NOTE: It is undetermined at this time whether this project will be done with motor pave or asphalt.
4. The Trustees instructed Jerry Hull to repair the culvert at Walter Anderson's property.

Mr. Londot moved to adjourn, seconded by Mr. Torrens, vote unanimous.
