The Washington Township Board of Trustees met this date in regular session for the purpose of transacting business of the Township.



1. Resolution 92-11 - Mr. Londot moved that the Washington Township Board of Trustees submit a joint application with the Morgan Township Board of Trustees (Knox County) for Issue 2 funding for the Bell Church Road Rehabilitation Project. Mr. Hull seconded, vote unanimous.
2. Resolution 92-12 - Mr. Torrens moved and Mr. Hull seconded, vote unanimous to approve the following transfer of funds between appropriations: From 01-M-02, \$2500.00 transferred to: 01-A-15, \$1000.00; 01-A-16, \$1000.00; 01-J-02, \$500.00.
3. The Trustees directed the Clerk to send Mr. Nickles and Mr. Berger a letter stating that the matter of line fence between their properties is closed.
4. The Trustees discussed the problem with dust control on the Township roads. They will look into why salt water has not been applied to the roads.

Mr. Londot moved to adjourn, seconded by Mr. Torrens, vote unanimous.
