1. Mr. Torrens reported that the bid package for the Bell Church Rehabilitation Project has been completed. Advertising to the contractor will be in the Mt. Vernon and Newark newspapers on May 10, 17, and 24.
2. Jerry Hull reported that he has spread three loads of gravel on Wilson Rd. to date. This is part of the gravel paid for by Don Lacey.
3. The Trustees discussed mowing at the Township building. In the past the North Fork Schools mowed the lot for the Township and at this point it is unclear whether they will be doing it again this year or not.
4. The Trustees again discussed the proposed minimum security prison to be located in the Village of Utica. The Trustees can not see any advantage of having this facility in the Village of Township. The Trustees once again urge the Village to take great consideration in their decision before allowing this facility to be placed in the Village.
5. Mr. Torrens reported that Mac Buckenberger called him about off-road vehicles and 4-wheel drive trucks using the part of Wilson Rd. previously closed by the Trustees. Mr. Torrens reported that to the best of his knowledge that property reverted back to the adjacent property owners and that the Township had no further jurisdiction over that section of the road.




