1. The Trustees discussed the right-of-way problem on Wilson Road. No action taken.
2. Mr. Londot talked with Mr. Joseph and Mr. Dean recently about the rehabilitation on Bell Church Road. They OK'd the bank work that will be done on their properties.
3. The North Fork Schools reported that they will mow the Township lot if the Township grades the parking lots at the school bus garage, high school and at Newton Elementary. The Trustees decided that they would not grade the parking lot at Newton Elementary due to the fact that it is too far to take the grader and that this school is located outside of the Township.
4. The Trustees discussed the proposed asphalt plant in Newton Township. Kokosing Material applied for this plant and it is unlikely the Newton Township Trustees will grant this request. The next site this could possibly be located in is Washington Township behind Johnson's Lumber Co. No action taken.
5. Mary Brilla reported that she had a water problem at her property on Bell Church Rd. She said that her driveway culvert is plugged and that the ditches on her side of the road have not been cleaned out. The Trustees informed Mrs. Brilla that she was on Morgan Township's end of the road and that she needed to talk to them about getting the problem solved.


