The Trustees referred the VanAttas to James Dickson. If Mr. Dickson would not grant them a variance they would have to go before the zoning appeals board.
4. The Trustees reported that on September 9, they met with Tim Lollo on the Peatmoss Road Rehabilitation Project.
5. Mr. Torrens reported that Don Peters was buried with funds from his family, this matter will not require funds from the Township.
6. The Trustees discussed having an engineering company engineer the Peatmoss Road Rehabilitation Project at a cost of approximately 10% of the total project.

Mr. Londot moved to adjourn, seconded by Mr. Torrens, vote unanimous.
