3. The Board discussed the trailer that is on Dick Vanatta's property on Weaver Road. The Trustees were uncertain as to whether the trailer should be there or not. Mr. Coad will contact Jim Dickson to see if he is aware of the situation and what needs to be done.
4. The Board discussed the zoning meeting on March 17th with the County Prosecutor. One important point brought out at this meeting:
  - use variance that was grandfathered in before zoning ordinances ~~was~~ in effect unless the use is stopped for a two year period or longer.
5. Jerry Hull reported that the culvert on Stout Rd. at Emerson Stout's home was sinking and ~~would~~ need repairs or replaced in the near future. *will*
6. Mr. Coad received another price for guardrail; \$6.90 per foot for new guardrail and \$4.90 per foot for used guardrail.

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


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7. The Board again discussed placing guardrail along Ginger Hill Road.
