The Washington Township Board of Trustees met this date in regular session for the purpose of transacting business of the Township.



1. Mr. Coad reported that a township resident called him to talk about the ditches on Richards Road being too deep. The Board will look into the matter.
2. Mr. Torrens reported that he talked with Jim Dickson about the trailer on Dick Vanatta's property. Mr. Dickson said that the Vanatta's were to have the trailer off the property by Feb. 1, 1994, but they were having trouble finding a trailer park that would take it.

Mr. Torrens also spoke to Mr. Dickson about the trailers, tires and junk cars behind the old Valley Inn on St. Rt. 13. Mr. Dickson will look into the matter.
3. The Clerk reported that he had received a BP credit card and issued it to Jerry Hull for the purchase of gasoline for the township trucks.
4. Mr. Torrens reported that someone was burning old tires near the Kaufman property on Wince Road. The Utica and Homer Fire Departments handled the situation.
5. Mr. Torrens reported that he spoke with County Engineer Tim Lollo about guardrail on Ginger Hill Road. Mr. Lollo will look into the situation and see if the county will build the guardrail next to the bridge.




Mr. Hull moved to adjourn, seconded by Mr. Torrens, vote unanimous.
