3. The Board had more discussion on H.B. 308; it is uncertain what action the Trustees will take at this time.
4. Jerry Hull reported that the Shelly Co. was to apply oil to the part of Cooksey Road at Kevin Londot's home which broke up after chip and sealing it. The Board will look into the matter.
5. Jerry Hull reported that the culvert for Weaver Road has been ordered.
6. The Board discussed interest rates for the purchase of a new tractor for the Township. National City Bank in Utica is the lowest at approximately 5 1/2%.
7. Mary Brillo was present and reported to the Board on four items:
  - a) The tar on BellChurch road is bleeding and getting all over her vehicles.
  - b) The culvert at Carl Lees' home is plugged up.
  - c) The water from BellChurch Road is washing out Freeman Mast's field.
  - d) The ditches on Richards Road are too deep.

The Board will look into all of these problems.

Mr. Torrens moved to adjourn, seconded by Mr. Hull, vote unanimous.
