2. The Board discussed the ~~problems the Utica EMS is having~~ *Utica EMS Problems getting* enough people to respond to calls during the daytime hours. The Board had some questions as to whether hiring part-time help during those hours will solve the problem or not.
3. The Licking County Juvenile Court sent the Board a letter asking if they would like to use some juvenile delinquents to help with the Township's road maintenance this summer. The Board declined the offer due to the lack of manpower to supervise the young people.
4. The Board voiced some concern about running out of stone to take care of the Township's roads when <sup>the</sup> weather breaks.
5. Resolution 96-04 - Mr. Coad moved that Washington Township adopt a Drug and Alcohol Testing Program equal to the Licking County Engineer's program. Seconded by Mr. Londot, vote unanimous.
6. Jerry Hull reported that several Township road signs have been vandalized.
7. The Board discussed the junk tire problem along the Township's roads. They will look into a cost-efficient way to get rid of the tires.
8. The Board discussed the water problem ~~along~~ Hunt Road. They will try ditching the road to see if that takes care of the problem.


9. The Board discussed the town meeting held at the Utica High School.


10. The Board will look into submitting another Issue II Project.
