1. The Board discussed the high grass problem along the Township's roads. They will get Benny Klick and Jerry Hull back out on the roads to make one more pass.
2. Mr. Coad reported that a tree fell across ~~Weaver~~ ^{Stout} Road. Mr. Coad cut up and removed the tree from the road.
3. The Board reported that Jack Dunn is on the job scraping and painting the Township Building.
4. The Board discussed Horns Hill Road and reported that Mr. Bullock has until September 27th to remove the fence on the east side of the road so they can grade and make the roadway 14' wide.
5. The Board discussed new laws governing the Township's requirements for CDL licenses and drug testing for employees plowing snow during designated snow emergencies.
6. The Board discussed the proposed Issue II project for Weaver and Smoot Roads. They have questions on starting date, completion date, and if they will carry the project over into 1998. County Engineer Tim Lollo's estimate for the project is \$283,040.00.
7. The Board discussed whether the Township is required to keep on file reports from all accidents on the Township's roads.
8. The Board discussed possible future law suits arising from Township zoning regulations which affect the value of individual properties within the Township.
9. Jerry Hull reported that some school bus drivers complained about ruts in

Mr. Londot moved to adjourn, seconded by Mr. Coad. Vote unanimous.




